SUPERVISORS SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR  
FUNDING FROM THE SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN  
DELTA CONSERVANCY FOR THE BEES LAKES  
RESTORATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, in 2009, the California legislature enacted Senate Bill 1, which established the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy ("Conservancy") in the Natural Resources Agency, and

**WHEREAS**, the Conservancy is required to act as the primary state agency to implement ecosystem restoration in the Delta and to support efforts that advance environmental protection and the economic well-being of Delta residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 1, the "Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014," was enacted by the voters on November 4, 2014 to provide a comprehensive and fiscally responsible approach for addressing the array of issues facing California's limited water resources; and

**WHEREAS**, in Proposition 1, \$50 million is identified for the Conservancy "for competitive grants for multi-benefit ecosystem and watershed protection and restoration projects in accordance with statewide priorities (Sec. 79730 and 79731)"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Conservancy's Grant Application Guidelines require entities submitting full proposals to secure a resolution from the County Board of Supervisors within which the project is located; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 22, 2017, the Conservancy invited the City of West Sacramento ("City") to submit a full proposal to prepare the Bees Lakes Restoration Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bees Lakes Restoration Plan supports implementation of the Regional Trails Initiative advocated by the City in partnership with Yolo County; and

**WHEREAS**, implementation of the Bees Lakes Restoration Plan would improve a degraded area within the City that currently attracts unwanted uses; and

**WHEREAS**, implementation of the Bees Lakes Restoration Plan would provide a wildlife viewing and open space amenity for Yolo County residents who reside within and near the City of West Sacramento.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors supports funding by the Conservancy for the preparation of the Bees Lakes Restoration Plan.

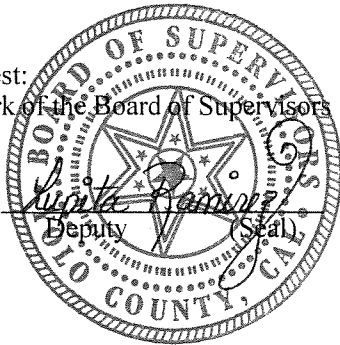
