The loss of foot-access to LIER via the Bridge will eliminate recreational opportunities for many hunters, anglers, and bird watchers who don't have the ability to purchase and maintain a boat capable of accessing the island from the nearest boat launches, making recreation impacts by the Project disproportionately affect lower income individuals and communities.
