

YOLO BYPASS WILDLIFE AREA HABITAT AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Determining if a Covered Action that is subject to the consistency certification requirements of the Delta Reform Act.

Water Code Section 85057.7 "Covered Action"

Will occur, in whole or in part, within the boundaries of the Delta or Suisun Marsh: **Yes**

Will be carried out, approved, or funded by the state or a local public agency: **Yes. The project will need to be approved by CDFW. Funding for project implementation is unknown, but possibly through CDFW Prop 1 funds or other agency Prop 1 funds in the future.**

Is covered by one or more provisions of the Delta Plan: **Yes. The policy to "Restore Habitats and Appropriate Elevations (23 CCR Section 5006) covers projects that include habitat restoration. The policy to "Protect Opportunities to Restore Habitat" (23 CCR Section 5007) covers projects in identified priority habitat restoration areas, which includes the Yolo Bypass.**

Will have a significant impact on achievement of one or both of the coequal goals or the implementation of government-sponsored flood control programs to reduce risks to people, property, and state interests in the Delta: **Yes. The coequal goals are "providing a more reliable water supply for California, and protecting, restoring, and enhancing the Delta ecosystem." When constructed, the project would have a significant positive effect on protecting, restoring, and enhancing the Delta ecosystem.**
