Dear Parties and Delta Protection Commission:

On April 7, 2020, Westlands Water District ("Westlands") filed a <u>Certification of Consistency</u> for the Lower Yolo Restoration Project. The Solano County Water Agency <u>submitted an appeal</u> of this Certification on May 7, 2020.

On June 12, 2020, the Solano County Water Agency ("SCWA") formally withdrew its appeal of the Lower Yolo Ranch Restoration Project Certification of Consistency.

Pursuant to Water Code section 85225.15, Westlands Water District can proceed to implement the covered action.

Under Rule 26 of our <u>Appeals Procedures</u>, Council members and staff face certain restrictions in the ex parte communications they may have while appeals are pending. Now that the appeal of the certification of consistency has been withdrawn, those restrictions are lifted.
